Plans are required for all building types and shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to Act 299 of the Public Acts of 1980, as amended, and shall bear that architect's or engineer's signature and seal, except: 1) One and two-family dwellings containing not more than 3,500 sq. ft. of building area. 2) Alterations and repair work determined by the plumbing official to be of a minor nature. 3) Buildings with a required plumbing fixture count less than 12. 4) Work completed by a governmental subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000

*Homeowner Affidavit: I hereby certify the plumbing work described on this permit application shall be installed by myself in my own home in which I am living or about to occupy. All work shall be installed in accordance with the State Plumbing Code and shall not be enclosed covered up, or put into operation until it has been inspected and approved by the County Inspector. I will cooperate with the County Inspector and assume the responsibility to arrange for all necessary inspections.

**Item #21, Domestic Water Treatment and Filtering Equipment: A license is not required for the installation of domestic water treatment and filtering equipment that requires modification to an existing cold water distribution supply and associated water piping in buildings if a permit is secured, required inspections performed and the installation compiles with the applicable code. If the enforcing agency determines a violation exists, it shall be corrected by the responsible installer. The permit application shall include the application fee, the number of water treatment devices recorded in item #21 for \$5.00 each and the approopriate water distribution pipe (system) size fee.
